ENGLISH

Students will investigate a range of informative texts; reading and writing about places and celebrations studied in HASS. Students will analyse and respond to visual, procedural and informational texts and discuss audience and purpose.

They will create a portfolio of work.
Students will continue to learn spelling rules and letter sound relationships and patterns.

MATHEMATICS

Students will continue to build understanding of place value. They will classify numbers as odd or even and continue number patterns. They will recall addition and multiplication facts. They will recognise the connection between addition and subtraction. Students will represent and calculate multiplication using a range of strategies. They will explore measurement, time and money.

HASS

This term students will be investigating boundaries in our own country and discovering our closest neighbours. They will research the meaning of symbols and significant celebrations and commemorations in our states and territories. Students will make and compare maps from different eras in Australia's history. They will design a flag; explaining their choices

VISUAL ARTS

Students will explore the seven elements of art and create a portfolio of work to demonstrate their understanding.

Students will create a bilingual 'collector card' for an Olympic athlete, including details such as the sport, country, and adjectives to describe the athlete written in Japanese script.
