Cairns was made a town in 1903. A rail line helped more people to move to Cairns so the population increased.



The city of Cairns was named after Sir William Wellington Cairns who was the state governor at the time.

- The Cairns region has the world's largest lava tubes. They are about 190 000 years old.
- Cairns has the highest mountain in Queensland. It is called Mount Bartle Frere and is 1611 metres high.
- Six of the seven sea turtle species are found around Cairns.

Kuranda Scenic Railway and Skyrail Rainforest Cableway

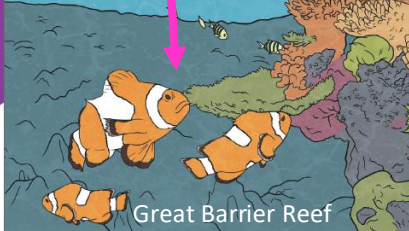

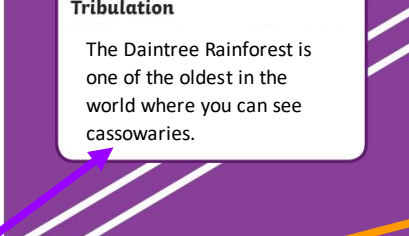
