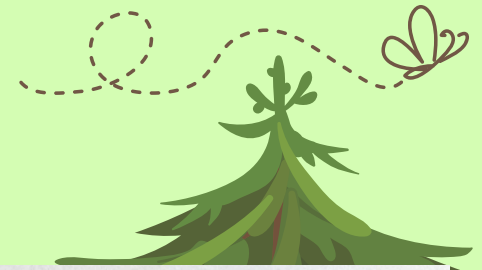

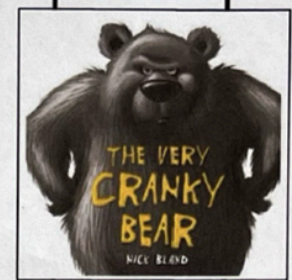


1. Draw the characters in the story. (who)

2. Draw the setting of the story. (where)

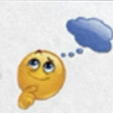


Moose was in a cave when it was raining.

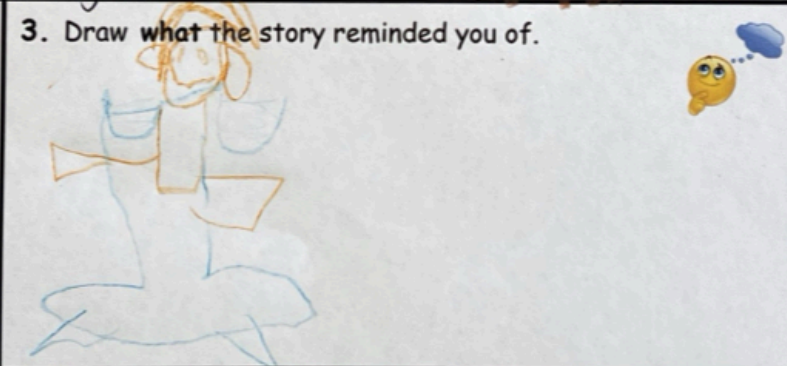
## APPLYING EXEMPLAR
