This funding will be used to

- Maintain the percentage of students receiving an 'A' or 'B' in all Learning Areas at 60% by the end of 2022.
- Increase the percentage of students receiving an 'A' or 'B' in English at 60% by the end of 2022.
- Maintain the percentage of students receiving an 'A' or 'B' in Mathematics at 70% by the end of 2022.
- Improve teacher capability through focused coaching and professional development to improve student performance.

Our initiatives include

- Employ an Instructional Coach to explicitly support and target teacher needs.
- Provide opportunities for teachers to collaboratively plan and review curriculum units to ensure there is consistency in planning, assessment and moderation across all year levels.
- Continue to embed the Mount Cotton Professional Learning Community/Teams that supports staff through a solid and dependable performance and development culture.
- Review the school Pedagogical Framework (Mount Cotton Method) and embed it as the shared language of teaching and learning.
- Provide intensive support for students demonstrating high levels of achievement by employing an Altitude Pioneer to implement our extension program across Learning Areas.
- Provide focused and intensive teaching (e.g. ELF program) for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards.
